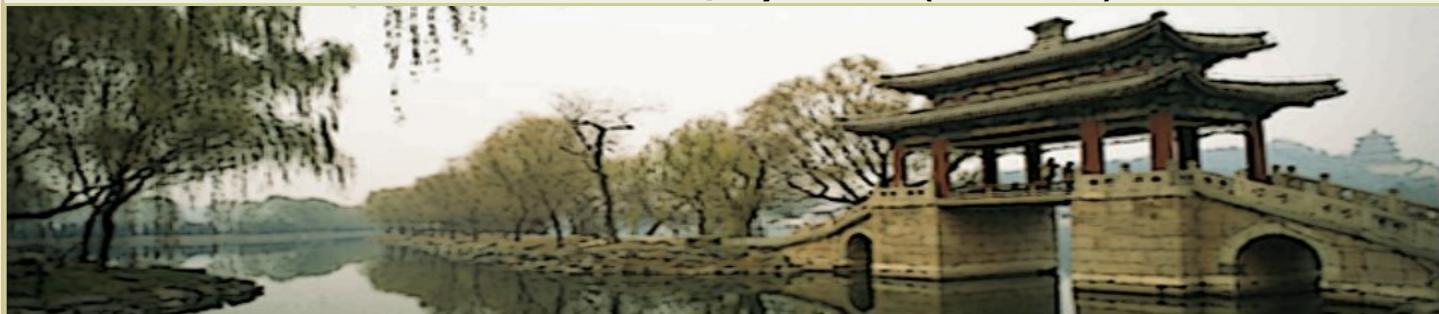


## Minor in Asian Studies

Now can be taken fully Online (see below)



**In-class and Online courses can be combined to complete the 15 credits.** This program is designed as an interdisciplinary approach with a flexible schedule for working professionals as well as full-time or part-time students interested in careers in international business, state or federal government, foreign affairs, education, and more. Students majoring in another academic discipline can now earn the 15 credits for the Minor in Asian Studies entirely Online.

### **Program Requirements (15 credits)**

A grade of "C" or better is required for all courses  
(C- is not acceptable).

#### • **Required Courses (3 credits)**

#### • **Asian Area Studies Courses (12 credits)**

Students must choose an additional 4 courses in Asian Area Studies. A maximum of 2 (6 credits) of language courses may be applied.
