GRADUATE PROGRAM CERTIFICATE

The Asian Studies Program offers a number of Certificate Programs, which are available to degree-seeking students at the graduate level. Each certificate requires **15 credits** of studies with a specific focus on an aspect of Asian culture, society, language, or business. Students may enroll in and take courses toward a certificate program prior to graduation; however, certificates cannot be awarded until the student has attained an M.A. or its equivalent graduate degree program from FIU. ASIAN GLOBALIZATION GRADUATE CERTIFICATE

The Asian Globalization graduate certificate requires a total of fifteen (15) credits and includes the following:

- a) Core in Asian Studies (9 credits): Three courses in Asian Studies. Can be ASN or another prefix. See sample listing of courses in the catalog focused on the studies of Asia or a sub-region (additional courses will be considered).
- b) Electives in Globalization (6 credits): Two courses from sample listing of globalization courses in the catalog: African Studies; European Studies; Latin American Studies; or Middle Eastern Studies. For additional courses in other world regions inquire with the Asian Studies Program.

Asian Globalization coursework listed on the catalog to be chosen with the approval of the Director (with a "C" or better). In addition to the courses listed in the catalog, relevant special topics, independent study, study abroad credits, and area studies or comparative studies may also be applied. Students should consult an advisor for the certificate program about current course offerings and a full list of courses accepted for the certificate.

Language: Language proficiency as appropriate for student's area of specialization.

Students must apply early for the graduate certificate to not delay the graduation term and certificate processing. Payment is required and it must be paid promptly to the OneStop/FIU Graduate Admissions office. Students cannot pursue a graduate certificate as a stand-alone program; graduate certificates must be sought alongside a graduate degree program. Contact an advisor for details.
