## *New!* Undergraduate Certificate in Korean Studies

Available next Fall 2023

The **Undergraduate Certificate in Korean Studies** is awarded by the FIU Asian Studies Program. This new certificate program provides an interdisciplinary approach focused on Korean cultural studies. It offers an 18-credit sequence of courses and is intended to provide students with a rich learning experience in Korean Studies to learn more about this increasingly important region of the world and to enhance the student's career competitiveness upon graduation. The program provides a multidisciplinary approach focusing on Korean cultural studies while covering topics in history, geography, politics, religion, sociology/anthropology, and international relations. *Open to degree-seeking students only.*

### **CERTIFICATE REQUIREMENTS (18 credits)**

#### **Core Requirements** (12 credits)

Four courses in Korean and East Asian area studies (history, religion, international relations, sociology, etc.) with 6 credits of ASN prefix courses.

#### **Language** (6 credits)

Two semesters of Korean language courses  
(Note: First year language courses are 5-credits each, for a total of 10, but 6 credits will be applied to certificate)
