B.A. IN ASIAN STUDIES CHINESE AREA STUDIES MAJOR		

The Asian Studies B.A. requires 36 credits. It is designed to allow students to focus on Asian political economy and culture in the context of global studies, as well as East Asian languages. However, all students must earn 120 credits in order to be eligible for graduation. The Asian Studies Bachelor's degree with the Chinese Area Studies Major emphasizes Chinese language and culture as well as other courses in area studies. It requires 9 credits of Core Courses: Introduction to East Asia (ASN 3410); China Then and Now (ASN 3016), and either Dynamics of Asia (ASN 4510) or Modern Asia (ASN 4390), or equivalent. Next, 9 credits in China-Specific Courses (see below). In addition, students must complete 9 credits of Asian Area Studies Electives. Because understanding language is paramount to understanding culture, students must achieve 9 credits of an intermediate level of Chinese language (first year of language, CHI 1130 and CHI 1131, are considered prerequisites). If a student tests out of language courses, they must fulfill the requirements with additional coursework. Contact asian@fiu.edu for more information.
