Asian Studies Program Requirements Checklist

❧ B.A. in Asian Studies ❧

To enter the Asian Studies Program, fill out the appropriate paperwork with the university to state your major plan of study. Completion of the Asian Studies Program requires only 36 credits. However, all students must earn 120 credits in her or his Undergraduate career in order to be eligible for graduation. There are a few requirements that students must meet to complete the Online Asian Studies Bachelor's Degree. Introduction to East Asia (ASN 3410) and East Asian Civilization (ASH 4300) are the only courses that students are specifically required to take. However, all students must also take 9 credits from ASN-prefix courses and 9 credits in Asia-related courses available online from the Asian Studies course list. In addition, each student must take 6 credits in her/his main concentration (Fully Online Asian Studies B.A.). Because understanding language is paramount to understanding culture, students must achieve some proficiency in an Asian language (e.g. Japanese, Chinese). Only levels one and two are available online. Contact asian@fiu.edu for more information.
