To enter the Asian Studies Program, fill out the appropriate paperwork with the university to state our major plan of study. Completion of the Asian Studies Program takes only 36 credits; however, all udents must earn 120 credits in their undergraduate career in order to be eligible for graduation. There are a few requirements that students must meet to complete the Asian Studies Bachelor's egree with the Japanese Area Studies Major. Students are required to complete Introduction to East Asia ASN 3410), History of Japan (ASH 3440), and Japanese Culture and Society (JPN 3500). Students must so complete two capstone/seminar courses: East Asian Civilizations and Cultures (ASH 4300) and ther Dynamics of Asia (ASN 4510) or Modern Asia (ASN 4390) (or equivalent). Japanese Area Studies lajors must also complete 9 credits of Japanese or Asian Area Studies electives. Because understanding language is paramount to understanding culture, students must achieve an avanced level (12 credits) of the Japanese language (first year of language, JPN 1130 and JPN 1131, are onsidered prerequisites). If a student tests out of language courses, s/he must fulfill the requirements ith additional course work.
