UNDERGRADUATE PROGRAM CERTIFICATE

The Asian Studies Program offers a number of Certificate Programs, which are available to degree-seeking students at the undergraduate level. Each certificate requires **18 credits** of studies with a specific focus on an aspect of Asian culture, society, language, or business. Students may enroll in and take courses toward a certificate program prior to graduation; however, certificates cannot be awarded until the student has attained a B.A. or its equivalent from FIU. KOREAN STUDIES UNDERGRADUATE CERTIFICATE

The Korean Studies certificate requires a total of eighteen (18) credits and includes the following:

a) Korean Studies and East Asian Area Studies (12 credits): Four courses in Korean/East Asian history, religion, economics, international relations, etc., must be completed from the coursework listed in the catalog to be chosen with the approval of the Director (with a "C" or better), with 6 credits of ASN-prefix courses. In addition to the courses listed in the catalog, relevant special topics, area studies, comparative studies, or study abroad courses may also be applied. Contact an advisor for details.

b) Language (6 credits): Two courses of Introductory-level (1000) or higher in Korean Language. (First-year language courses are 5-credits each, for a total of 10, but a maximum of 6 first-year credits will be applied to the certificate). If students test out of some portion of this requirement, they must complete additional credits in Korean and/or East Asian society and culture. Korean language may be substituted by a Korean Studies course if a language course is not available. Students may earn three to six credits for study abroad and up to fifteen credits for student exchange).

Korean/East Asian Studies and Language coursework listed in the catalog. Students should consult with an advisor for the certificate program about current course offerings and a full list of courses accepted for the certificate. Additional language credits may also be considered.
